___ **Chaperone** – For bus travel

___ **Spirit Wear and CD Sales** – Help with sales of CD's, optional T-shirts, yard signs and car decals during Band Concerts.

___ **Football Refreshments** – Would include icing down, transporting of coolers/ bottled water to and from Marcus stadium for band students for 2 Lamar football games.

___ Sorting and distributing items (Nov 11 3:30-5:15pm)

___ Food Donation – Donating goodies and drinks to be sold at the ball

___ Decorating – Must be at the school at 4pm on the day of the ball to decorate.

___ Chaperone – Come dressed in costume and help where needed.

___ **Uniforms** – Would include fitting Symphonic and Concert students with formal uniforms during band class the week of November 9 from 10:15am-noon. Also, to help check uniforms back in, June 2.

___ **Winter Party** - Help plan, set up, chaperone and/or clean up for this event on December 12th

Community Garage Sale – In March or April (Saturday) 6:30am-2:20pm – will work in shifts

___ Provide garage space for storage prior to sale

___ Provide tables for day of sale

___ Provide truck(s) the day of sale for transporting items

___ Work a shift on the day of sale (date unknown at this time but has been between 6:30am – 2:30pm)

Practice Marathons – Would include set up, serving and clean up of dinner after the practice for all bands. Concert and Symphonic also have “fun” time after dinner so chaperones are needed.

___ **Summer Band** – Would include setting up, serving and/or cleaning up, for meals provided during rehearsals the week before school begins in August (2010).
